COURSE DESCRIPTION

Medi-Cal coverage is the payer for nearly two-thirds of the nursing facility population. In addition, as the population ages, issues regarding treatment decisions are becoming prevalent.

1. Understand the eligibility requirements for single and married people, so that you can better help your clients get the benefits they are entitled to;
2. Ensure that your clients are accurately informed about Medi-Cal Recovery issues; and
